

COST OF SERVICES



All information, referral and support services are provided free of charge.

Housing Establishment Funds are generally provided as non-repayable grants in the case of rent arrears. In other circumstances they may be Interest free loans.

If transitional housing is provided subject to income and assessment eligibility, rent is charged at the same rate as public housing in Victoria.

CONTACT WAYSS



There are no addresses given in this brochure as WAYSS does not generally offer a drop in service (even though you will be made welcome at their locations). To avoid a long wait it is best to call and talk to a worker about your situation first.

If an appointment is required they will discuss the best location option to suit you.

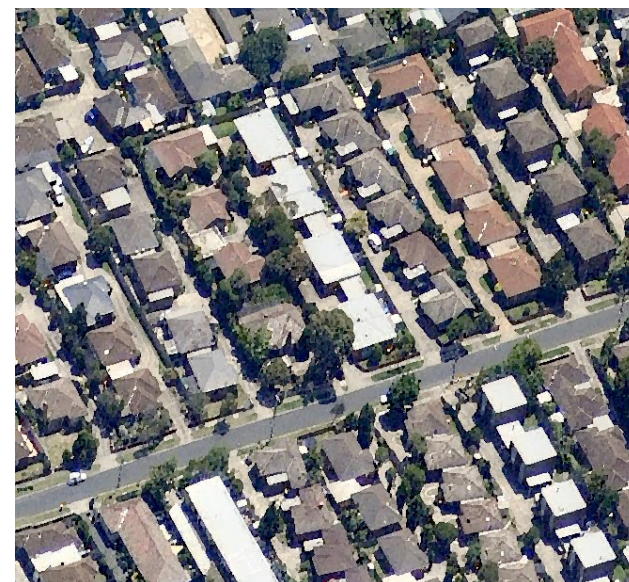

WAYSS YOUTH SUPPORT PROGRAM



Crisis and transitional support to single young people who are homeless or at risk of becoming homeless. This service aims to increase their capacity to live independently through improving access to long term secure and affordable housing, income and a range of social supports. Case management based on individualised support plans to assist young people reach their full potential.

PRIVATE RENTAL ACCESS PROGRAM



Time and amount limited private rental subsidy to ensure client does not lose accommodation while being assisted with other issues. **Accessible by worker referral only to clients involved with specific services in the south-east region.**

SOCIAL HOUSING ADVOCACY and SUPPORT PROGRAM



Voluntary program requiring client consent for referral. Intervention for at-risk tenancies. Advocacy and assistance to establish tenancy for Early Housing applicants. The program is unable to pay rent arrears or maintenance debts owed to the Office of Housing.
